Cluny Sisters Celebrate 150 Years in Peru

When our sisters in Peru celebrated the 150th anniversary of the arrival of Cluny Sisters in Peru with Mass in the cathedral in Lima on June 7th that was broadcast on national television, we joined them in spirit. Cluny Sisters landed in Lima on June 8, 1870 to begin a new foundation. French immigrants, many of whom were skilled artisans from the south
