# Connecting with Cluny Affiliates Around the World

**luny Affiliates are lay persons** honored by our Congregation as benefactors who have brought a wide range of presence and support to our communities and our mission, including their talent, time, and treasure. They have become a part of our lives and furthered our mission, and so they benefit through the spiritual affiliation from the merits of the prayers and good works of the sisters in life and in death.

Affiliates are connected with the province that recommends them, but they may live in other parts of the world. Three couples from North America have been affiliates of a province in India, and another couple have been affiliates of the Province of the West Indies.

Some of our Affiliates first became involved as Cluny Associates and now belong to both of these important groups of co-workers in the vineyard of the Lord.

The story of Blessed Anne Marie Javouhey, her life's work and her mission with the poor quickly became an integral part of my life. I learned of the Sister's work in numerous areas of the world.
